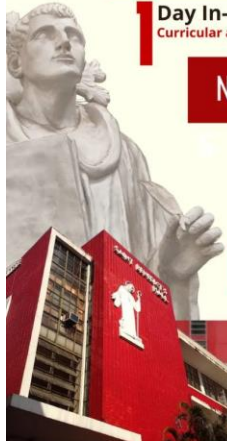

1 What is 4-1 Flexible Learning Modality of the IBED-SBU?

The IBED-SBU 4-1 Flexible Learning Modality combines Online and In-person engagement. The IBED adopts this learning design for Academic Year 2022-2023 to create and ensure a balance in the spiritual, mental, social, emotional well-being, and cognitive development of the students.

There will be 4 days of Synchronous and Asynchronous Learning Activities and 1 Day In-Person Classes to provide the students with a more interactive and meaningful learning experience through curricular and co-curricular activities.

The 1-Day In-Person Classes will be done semi monthly by cluster.

How many students will there be in a classroom during the 1 day In-Person activity?

The school will adhere to the Department of Education's recommended number of students per classroom. For most In-Person activities, the school intends to maximize the use of outdoor learning venues. The same number of students will be accommodated during the full Face-to-face classes.

What are the learning activities during the 1 day In-Person activity?

Since the utmost consideration upon return to physical school is to address the spiritual, mental, social, emotional well-being, and cognitive development of the students, these will be some of the learning activities that will be carried out:

Are students required to attend the 1 day In-Person activity?

Students are required to attend and maximize the In-Person learning opportunities. The policy on attendance will be strictly enforced with consideration on family emergency, illness, quarantine, and isolation concerns.

Are the students required to wear the school uniform during the 1 day In-Person activity?

Proper dress code will be observed during the 1 day In-Person activity. School uniforms will be required during the full Face-to-face classes.

8 Is there a provision in the 4-1 Flexible Learning Modality for students who are staying in faraway regions or outside the country?

Yes. Students who are staying in faraway regions or outside the country will be provided with a Special Program complementary to In-Person activities.

However, all students will be required to attend full Face-to-face classes by November 7, 2022 as mandated by the DepEd Order # 34 Series of 2022.

9 What would be the health requirements for students during the 1 day In-Person activity and full Face-to-face classes?

Students will follow and observe the health and safety requirements as mandated by the Department of Education and SBU protocols.
